1. A letter from a degree-granting college/university verifying enrollment.
2. A letter from ACT member verifying internship.
3. An official transcript from the degree-granting college/university attended. (Must be supplied directly from the institution and reflect the courses and cumulative grade point from the most recent academic semester attended.)
4. A two page essay. Candidate must prepare an essay. The essay topic will be changed annually and is limited to two pages at 12 pt font.

Junior Candidate Documents:

1. An official transcript from the degree-granting college/university attended. (Must be supplied directly from the institution from the most recent academic semester attended.) Cumulative grade point average must be at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
2. A letter of recommendation from a senior ACT member.
3. A two page essay. Candidate must prepare an essay. The essay topic will be changed annually and is limited to two pages at 12 pt font.
